WILDERNESS SEARCH & RESCUE

WILDERNESS SEARCH & RESCUE IS DEFINED AS ADVANCE RESCUE AND BASIC LIFE SUPPORT FUNCTIONS AS AN INITIAL RESPONDER WITH ADVANCED EQUIPMENT AND SKILLS.

5. NIMS TYPING INFORMATION:

This standard currently meets NMIS Typing Criteria IV. Organizations wishing to certify at a higher level must meet the additional requirements for personnel, training and equipment. Organizations who currently have 8 personnel who meet the NFPA 1670 Level of Wilderness Search and Rescue will meet NIMS Type III with the above equipment. Note: NFPA 1006 is the Professional Qualification for the Technical Rescuer while NFPA 1670 is the Standard on Operations and Training for Technical

Search and Rescue Incidents. The two should not be confused but work hand and hand with each other.
