WILDERNESS SEARCH & RESCUE IS DEFINED AS ADVANCE RESCUE AND BASIC LIFE SUPPORT FUNCTIONS AS AN INITIAL RESPONDER WITH ADVANCED EQUIPMENT AND SKILLS.

### 5. NIMS TYPING INFORMATION:

This standard currently meets NMIS Typing Criteria IV. Organizations wishing to certify at a higher level must meet the additional requirements for personnel, training and equipment. Organizations who currently have 8 personnel who meet the NFPA 1670 Level of Wilderness Search and Rescue will meet NIMS Type III with the above equipment. To locate this information cut
